- ❁ Complete & Sign Form C: Acknowledgment of Receipt & Statement of Understanding of Florida 4-H Area & State Horse Shows Official Rules
- ❁ Make sure your 4-H Club Leader Submits Eligibility Form D, *only if you plan to participate in Area D Horse Show.*
- ❁ 4-H Club Leaders must make sure all forms (A to D) are completed and signed by Members, Parents and Leaders as required *(4-H Club, Project Leaders or Trainers are not responsible to submit these forms to the OC 4-H Office; it is responsibility of the members and parents.)*
